



Online Journals for Carers

The following instructions will enable carers to be able to access online journals on the Queensland State Library's website regarding Alzheimer's Disease and other forms of Dementia.

Below are instructions on how to access the journals.

1. Go to www.slq.qld.gov.au
2. Click on 'Databases and e-books' which is located under the 'Quick Links' heading on the homepage
3. It will then open to a new page that has a list of topics: Click on 'Health and Medicine'
4. Scroll down until you find the heading 'Health and Wellness Resource Centre'. Once you've found that, click on the link 'process'. (If you do not have the right access information, the process of applying for an e-services library membership card can be found in the 'Help' section on the homepage. You can find it under the 'Find...' heading at the top of the page.)
5. Once logged into the 'Health and Wellness Resource Centre', type 'Dementia' or 'Alzheimers' into the search engine to find journals specific to these diseases
